## REPORT FROM TREASURER

In my final report as Treasurer, it is reassuring to note that the net profit of \$25,014 was basically in line with our budgeted projections, apart from the unexpected receipt of a \$10,000 Covid-19 Cash Flow Boost from the Federal Government; a further \$10,000 will also be received in season 2020/21.

The upcoming season will provide some financial challenges however due to the effects of Covid-19 on the financial positions of Cricket Australia & Cricket Victoria and the very real possibility that some sponsors may not be in a position to support us in the way they have in past seasons. Unemployment could also affect our players and their ability to pay subscriptions and merchandise purchases. Our strong financial position should mean that we are able to cope with even the worst scenarios, but it may result in a reduction of funds which we had planned to contribute to the upcoming renovations & fitouts.
